Track important externals links (like downloads, sign-ups, login, etc) through event tracking An event is a user interaction with a web page element like videos
or external links. GA can't track such events by default as they don't generate pageviews when they occur. You can set up event tracking in GA by calling _trackEvent() method each time the user interaction you want to track occurs.
